

Your fees at work

The Teaching Council is an Independent Statutory Body working with more than 105,000 teachers across ECE, primary, secondary and is responsible for ensuring the:

- **quality of teaching,**
- **growing leadership capability and**
- **the safety of children.**

The new annual fee of \$157 (or \$3 per week) replaces a previous fee of \$220.80 paid every three years (\$1.40 per week). The increase will take effect February 2021.

The annual professional fees paid by teachers (\$157) will still be amongst the lowest of any group of professionals in New Zealand including Nurses (\$110), Midwives (\$475), Social Workers (\$445), Occupational Therapists (\$500), Physiotherapists (\$555), and Psychologists (\$551).
