Enhanced induction and mentoring



What is the enhanced induction and mentoring programme?

The enhanced induction and mentoring programme is a government-funded programme available free of charge to newly qualified teachers who had their initial teacher education practical experience impacted due to COVID-19.



Can I enrol?

YOU CAN ENROL IF:

You completed your initial teacher education in 2020, and

Your initial teacher education programme used the temporary 25% reduction in practical experience requirements, and

You are a registered teacher employed in a teaching role¹.

We strongly encourage all eligible teachers to enrol.



What does the programme include?

The enhanced induction and mentoring programme gives you free extra mentoring. You'll get a local university-based teaching mentor assigned to you.

YOUR MENTOR WILL:

Visit you at work and do two half-day teaching observations for you;

have two meetings with you and your work-based mentor, focusing on supporting your professional growth, goals, and reflections.
