


- Pou Here Tomua establishing and maintaining standards for initial teacher education and undertaking Initial Teacher Education programme approvals

- Pou Aro Whakamua steering the future direction of teaching




EoY 2022 Programme Approvals

84 approved programmes so far






Approved programmes by medium




2022 Programme Approvals

- Relates to ITE Requirement 9.2
- In 'transition space' for 2020-2023.
- Interim mode recognises needs for low burden during challenging years.
- Still working in conjunction with NZQA and external monitors for non-university programmes. Teaching Council external monitor for universities.
