- The Total Number is the number of teachers registered with a provisional practising certificate in that year.
- Teachers can move to a full practising certificate once they have completed at least 2 years of mentored teaching in a school, early childhood education setting or another approved setting.
- If a teacher hasn't moved to a full practising certificate 6 years after their first provisional practising certificate was issued, they will need to complete a Teacher Education Refresh programme before they can be issued another provisional practising certificate.
- At the 5 year mark (after a teacher's first provisional practising certificate was issued) teachers are sent a 'reminder' about needing to either apply for a full practising certificate or complete the Teacher Education Refresh programme.
